AGE DIVISIONS/DETERMINATION:

The athlete's year of birth shall determine the age division in which he/she will compete for individual events.

Relays will be run in 2 year age divisions:

- 8 Years, Born in 2009 & After (Primary)
- 9 Years, Born in 2008 (Sub-Bantam)
- 10 Years, Born in 2007 (Bantam)
- 11 Years, Born in 2006 (Sub-Midget)
- 12 Years, Born in 2005 (Midget)
- 13 Years, Born in 2004 (Sub-Youth)
- 14 Years, Born in 2003 (Youth)
- 15/16 Years, Born 2001-2002 (Intermediate)
- 17/18/19 Years, Born 1999-2000

***Competitors should bring their own implements to be used at Meet. Turbo Javelin immediately following Softball Throw.**
